

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

As a rule to be observed in abbreviations of words, omit their vowels and one letter of every doublet.

The following are the exceptions to this rule:

- 1. When a word begins with a vowel, retain that letter.
- 2. Words with a consonant at the begining and end, and a vowel or two in the middle, must be spelled in full.
- 3. When two or more words have the same consonants similarly located, at least one of their distinguishing vowels must be used, as "impassible for impassible, and "imposbl" for impossible.
- 4. When the omission of one letter of a doublet will form another word, both letters will be retained, as "lattr" for latter, not "latr" which would signify later.

The general order promulgating [the forgoing, as well as the abbreviation list below] was prefaced with the suggestion that the lack of familiarity with them on part of the officers and sergeants conducting [signal] stations would be:
